

## COVID-19 Policies and Procedures 2020-2021

We are very excited to get our dancers back into the studio for our Fall 2020-2021 dance season. We also want to do everything we can to keep our dancers and their families safe and healthy. Therefore, we please ask that you read over our new COVID-19 policies and procedures and sign and return the attached release form.

- All parents and/or guardians must sign a release form before a dancer will be permitted in class. These must be mailed in or returned to the studio by or on the first class.
- All dancers must wear masks.
- Class size will be limited to 6 dancers to allow for proper social distancing.
- Class times will be staggered for safe arrival and departure of the dancers.
- Teachers will clean and sanitize studio barres, floors, bathroom, door knobs, and other surfaces that may come in contact with students.
- Parents and siblings are not permitted in the studio. Dropoff and pickup will happen safely in the parking lot. The teacher will be at the entrance of the studio to welcome each child.
- Dance floor and barres will be marked to help dancers safely distance from each other.
- Dancers are encouraged to bring their own water bottle as we will not be selling water.
- If your child has been sick, or around anyone who has been sick, please do not send them to class.

- Arrival/Departure Procedure:
  - o Dancers must wait in the car until the teacher opens the door for class.
  - Each dancer will have a temperature check upon entering the studio and be required to use hand sanitizer.
  - The lobby and changing room will be closed. Students are to arrive dressed for class with their hair neatly tied back in a proper ballet bun. They may leave their dance bag and street shoes in the designated area in the lobby.
  - Classes will begin promptly and students may not be permitted into class late.
  - Classes will end promptly to allow time for each student to leave and the teacher to clean for the next class. Please be on time for pickup.
- Freyer Academy of Ballet will not issue a refund for any unused tuition should classes have to be taught virtually.
